

Review of income-banded Council Tax Reduction/Support schemes

Detailed information on schemes adopted in 2020-21



Introduction

Every year we research and record the range of Council Tax Reduction/Support (CTR) schemes being used by councils across the UK, so that users of our benefits calculators can get accurate and up-to-date information about their entitlement to this benefit.

As more and more claimants are moving to Universal Credit many Local Authorities (LAs) around the country are reviewing their CTR scheme to make them easier to administer and income-banded schemes are one response being used. This report provides details of the variety of different income-banded schemes that have been put in place for the 2020/21 year.

After reviewing the most up-to-date details available for CTR schemes for all 314 Local Authorities in England, we have found that 63 are running income-banded schemes for 2020/21. This is an increase on 33 from 2019/20.

Of these 63 LAs, 10 run the banded scheme for Universal Credit claimants only.

The following is an overview of the types of income-banded schemes in use, the income being taken into account and other common policy options. More details of each LA's income-banded scheme are provided at the end of this document.

Variation in household types

The majority of the income-banded schemes, 46 of the 63, fit into one of three formats, with the common practice being to place those on passported benefits (Income Support, income-based Jobseeker's Allowance, income-related Employment and Support Allowance and sometimes those on maximum Universal Credit with no other income) into the lowest income band.

Type 1: One set of income bands for all households

14 LAs have one set of income bands and associated reduction percentages which apply to all claimants, including the example given below for Arun District Council.

There were two more of this type of scheme in 2019 – Cotswold and West Oxfordshire - but the former has now changed to 10 household types and the later has moved to having 4 household types in 2020.

Type 2: Four household types

23 LAs have four different sets of income bands and associated reduction percentages to cover four different household types; Single, Couple, Households with one child, Households with two or more children. This includes the example given below for Rother District Council.

Type 3: Six household types

9 LAs have six different sets of income bands and associated reduction percentages to cover six different household types; Single, Couple, Single with one child, Couple with one child, Single with two or more children, Couple with two or more children. This includes the example given below for Somerset West and Taunton Council.

Other definitions of household type

Of the 17 LAs that haven't adopted one of these formats, 7 have only made slight variations, such as having more household types to include larger families - up to 4 children in some cases - or fewer household types such as, no children, 1 child, 2+ children.

The approach to protected groups (usually those in receipt of certain disability benefits, carers or households with a child under a certain age) is usually to treat them differently outside of the

income bands, ensuring they retain access to full/increased support. However, 9 LAs have introduced protected or vulnerable claimants into their 'household types', assigning more generous income bands and/or associated reduction percentages to this group.

Only one LA, South Cambridgeshire, has incorporated the council tax band into their household types. Their income bands are determined by whether you are single or in a couple and the council tax band of your property.

St Alban's, although running a scheme with one set of income bands for all claimants, has taken a different approach to other schemes as they use them to identify the contribution a claimant should make towards their council tax liability, rather than identifying a reduction percentage. As such, claimants with the same income will pay the same contribution towards their council tax, even if their council tax liability differs. Cambridge has since adopted this approach as well.

Variation in income used to assign to band

As under the default scheme, the majority of LAs are using assessed income to assign a household to the relevant band. However, significant variation exists in how much of the household's Universal Credit award they are taking into account as income.

- All but 11 LAs are disregarding an amount determined to be in relation to housing costs but some are also disregarding other elements such as the carer element, childcare element and disability related elements.
- 6 LAs stand apart in that their income bands are actually excess income bands, so their schemes retain the concept of applicable amounts. Claimants without excess income will be placed in the lowest band.
- 7 LAs only take earnings into account. Those without earnings will be placed in the lowest band.

Other policy options

Other notable variations lie in the treatment of non-dependant deductions (NDDs) and earnings disregards/additional earnings disregards, with many LAs taking a blanket policy approach to these, either removing them completely or setting a flat rate to be applied to all.

For example, 27 LAs have a flat rate earnings disregard. Those that retain multiple rates have tended towards increasing them. 29 LAs are applying their earnings disregard to UC claimants as well.

20 LAs have a flat rate (or 2 rate) non-dependant deduction structure, whereas 19 LAs have removed them completely.

Only 7 LAs have made no changes from the prescribed NDDs.

Some schemes retain policy options common within 'standard' schemes. For example: 25 LAs have a band cap (most frequently band D) and 40 LAs have reduced the upper capital limit (35 of these have reduced it to £6,000 or lower, thus removing tariff income from their schemes).
